- The protected areas of Lake Sempach must be observed.
- Any rule changes will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility

- Competitors must be members of an ISAF affiliated club.
- The Swiss Sailing regulations apply to Swiss participants. Licenses can be obtained in the regatta office.

Measurement checks

Random measurement checks can be carried out by the race committee or the jury.

Race schedule

Saturday May 28, 2022

09:00 - 11:30 a.m. Registration at the regatta office, delivery of sailing instructions

12:00 p.m. Skippers meeting

1:00 p.m. Announcement signal for the first race

Further races will be sailed as soon as possible after the previous race finishes.

Sunday May 29, 2022

09:00 a.m. readiness for departure

3:30 p.m. Last possible start time

Number of races: Max 6 (max. 4 per day)

Scoring

- One completed race is required for the series to be declared valid.
- Discards: When four or more valid races have been completed.

Prizes

Commemorative prizes for all participants

Berths and parking spaces

- Moorings and parking spaces according to the indications on site.
- Camping is not allowed in the club area! There is an excellent campsite nearby

Social arrangemants

- Free beer/bottled water on Saturday May 28, 2022
- Dinner/Apero in the clubhouse (registration required by Monday, May 23, 2022 you will be prompted for this when registering your boat)
- "Buvette" catering at the YCSe club

Liability and Insurance

- Persons participating in this regatta do so at their own risk
- Each participating boat must have sufficient liability insurance valid for racing risks.

By registering, I agree that audio and video recordings may be made at the event and these can be published (e.g., website, newspaper, etc.). Furthermore, I agree that the registration, results and other information about the event (including the names of the participants) may be published.
